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GAME ON!

1

SET UP

Set up your board on a flat surface.

2

DISTANCE



The distance you stand from the board is really up to you. The official competition distance is **8.2 meters**, but a good social distance is around **6 meters**.

We recommend standing a bit closer if you're just starting out or playing with younger or older participants.

For a quicker and more professional setup, the package includes a measuring meter rope and ground throwing ruler. These tools help you easily set the correct distance and ensure a consistent, accurate playing experience every time.

PLAYING

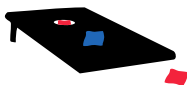


Each player has 4 of the same colored bags

- You can have 2 players or 2 teams but there are only 2 players each round.
- Use the measuring rope and ground throwing ruler for a professional setup.
- A foot over the line is a foot fault — no points, bag removed.
- Throws alternate — each player throws 1 bag at a time.
- After all 4 bags each, the round ends and you record the score.

4

SCORING



3 points in the hole

1 point on the board

0 points if touching the ground

1 V 1

- You get 3 points for a bag in the hole.
- You get 1 point for a bag on the board.
- If a bag touches the ground that is 0 points.

In a 1v1 cornhole game, each player has 4 bags and takes turns throwing them. Every bag that lands on the board is worth 1 point, and every bag that goes in the hole is worth 3 points. Bags that miss the board score 0. After each round, both players add their points to their total score. The first player to reach exactly 21 points wins the game.

2 V 2

Example A:

Player A has 2 bags in the hole and 2 on the board = **8 points for Player A**.

Player B has 1 bag in the hole and 3 bags on the board = **6 points for Player B**.

The higher score subtracts the lower and gains the difference.

Example B:

Player A has 8 points and **Player B** has 6 points ($8 - 6 = 2$).

Player A gets 2 points for the round

The team who scores the highest points throws first in the next round.

If no points are scored, the team who went first the previous round throws first again.

The first team to 21 points wins the game!
